Pria International Academy offers e-Programmes that make learning engaging, accessible and self-paced.




The Certificate Programmes run over 6 months and are delivered through a structured format divided into Units

On Completion, you receive a formal certificate.
















Your Programme Homepage




Once you have logged onto the programme you have registered for, you will land on your programme homepage.






The centre pane displays the programme introduction and the 6 units that you will be able to access gradually.






During the 1st month of the programme launch, you will be able to access the home page and the first unit.

Access to the 2nd Unit will be provided at the beginning of the 2nd month, to the 3rd Unit in the 3rd month and so on...






From the left pane you can engage in forum discussions, access the programme calendar, view other participants on the programme, and see your profile.






Your programme calendar has your programme dates highlighted.



Your first access to the units is through the home page. As mentioned previously, access to the units will be provided gradually along the programme.






Within a unit, you can navigate through the upper pane as well as return to the course home page.






It is advisable that you first watch the module overview available on the upper right hand pane.






In the central pane you find the unit overview and the unit objectives.






The left pane continues to be the same as the programme homepage. You can engage in forum discussions, access the programme calendar, view other participants on the programme, and see your profile.

- Course Content






You would be required to complete three assignments:


- Reflection paper

The quiz is a set of 20 questions that a participant is expected to answer – one at a time.





The result of each question attempted is displayed instantly.
